Description and Learning Objectives:

This epic compendium of exceptional high-definition video footage demonstrates in great detail the advances in image-enhanced endoscopy (IEE) currently available in the endoscopist's armamentarium, explaining each modality and technique with respect to its intended and potential clinical utility, its inherent features in enhancement of endoscopic visualization, and possible future applications from the esophagus and upper GI tract to the colon. Topics covered in this video include, but are not limited to, high-resolution versus high-definition imaging, sprayed dye-based image enhancement versus electronically-enhanced imaging, identification of mucosal patterns and mucosal vascular details highlighted by IEE, and the use of spray catheters and caps in IEE. Also featured are the complementarities of dye spraying and electronic image enhancement in the detection of metaplasia and neoplasia, applications in inflammatory bowel disease, and co-utilization of IEE with advanced mucosal resection techniques.
